

Sam Henrichs report:

I fished Lake Roosevelt out of 7 Bays on Superbowl Sunday.

Skies were sunny, wind a bit variable but mostly light. Produced a fair chop for part of the day.

Air 33, water 36.5.

No fish caught.

Marked many fish in Hawk Creek with sonar, but never touched one with a hook.

Tried some assorted jigs, and blades.

Ran over to the flat across from the 7 Bays launch and cruised it a bit on top and the drop off several places..Never marked anything, didn't really fish it.

Ran up above the rock to a steeper drop off and never really marked anything there either.

Ran over to casino flats, and never saw anything at all along the drop off or the top or the channel, as well as across from casino flats.

Checked out a couple of draws and rock piles running up onto outhouse flats, but marked nothing there and nothing up on the flats.

Ran out into deep water off of outhouse flats and marked groups of fish in 160' of water, but didn't really want to fish for them that deep.

Then up to Neighborly (sp?), and marked what looked like three walleye on the bottom along that 35-40' flat, all within 50 yards of each other. Marked them with waypoints and then repeatedly fished inside, outside, and right over them with no bites.

Buzzed across to the 50' hump, and didn't mark anything around there either.

Checked a lot of spots, and didn't really fish much as we didn't find much of interest except down deep.

I am learning some of the bottom in that area pretty well though with the use of structure scan.
